

WEEK TWO: WONKY SCULPTURE SUPPLY LIST

Some materials are used for more than one project.

Clay Totem Project

- Air-dry clay
- Pencil
- Plastic knife (use with adult supervision)
- Ruler
- Cookie cutters (optional)
- Rolling pin
- Cutting board or other hard surface
- Acrylic paint
- Dish of water
- Paper towels

3D Foam Sculpture Project

- Floral foam rectangle (large blocks can be cut in half for practice)
- Scissors
- Plastic spoon or plastic knife (any utensil that can be used for carving into the soft foam)
- Pencil or toothpicks
- Flat paint brushes for painting sculpture and brushing loose carvings
- Acrylic paint (optional)
- Stone spray paint (optional, to give the sculpture the look of a stone carving)
- Plastic bag
- Dish of water to seal loose shavings

Spirit Sticks Sculpture Project

- Sticks from your yard (look for interesting shapes: short, tall, bent, or with a "Y" shape)
- Acrylic paint (your choice of colors)

- Pot for the sticks to stand in
- Yarn (your choice of colors)
- Paint brushes
- Scissors
- Permanent markers
- Tacky glue
- Beans, rocks, or dirt to fill the pot so the sticks can stand up

Slot Sculpture Project

- Cardboard (cake or pizza round) or any available cardboard
- Paper plate
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Markers
- Acrylic paint
- Brush
- Yarn, foam, glitter (optional)

Parrot Sculpture Project

- Foam sheets (your choice of colors)
- Straw
- Scissors
- Toothpick
- Tape/masking or double sided
- Markers
- Air-dry clay for base
- Patterns for bird and feathers (see page 3)
